The Halloween Classic is meant to be a fun and social gathering, aimed towards the local Alberta exhibitor. We have added some fun competitions for everyone to enjoy.

We hope you have been preparing for the costume events and remind everyone that on jumper day, there will be a Costume Relay, where competitors will be required to perform a small skit dressed in costume, and then compete over a relay course against the clock. There will be two sets of ribbons. The first set will go to the teams with the clock being the deciding factor, while the second set will be awarded to the teams with the best costumes and skits based on the judges' scores and audience popularity.

For the hunters, we have added a team of three hunters competition, where again, skits will be performed by each team before their rounds and best costumes and skits will be rewarded. We will use longer than normal rails to help the pairs, and will adjust the heights accordingly to allow everyone the chance to compete.

During the team of three hunters on the Saturday, we would invite everyone to participate in a reception / dinner party, which will be held in the lounge of the farm. We invite you to bring your family and friends to cheer on the teams. There will be great food, and some fun activities to enjoy for everyone, including a pumpkin carving contest.
